



How it works:

1. Get in touch and request a free quote using the delivery enquiry form.
2. We aim to get back to you within 48hrs with a quote estimate based on the information provided about the vessel and passage in question.
3. If you are happy to proceed with the provided quote, our team will contact you with further paperwork for completion prior to our delivery crew arriving. At this point both parties can clarify any queries before signing a delivery contract, and paying a deposit
4. Once paperwork is in order and the deposit is paid, we will get crew in place, and logistics arranged around your requested dates, keeping you up to date providing information about the crew.
5. Crew typically arrive a minimum of 24hrs prior to the desired departure to provision and conduct a pre-delivery survey ensuring the vessel is fit for sea, with the condition report sent to the owner for their records. At this stage any issues will be made known to the owner and our team will endeavour to work with you to rectify them quickly.
6. Finally, with the vessel signed off for sea our skipper will depart at the first appropriate opportunity, based on the latest weather routing information and tides. Notifying the owner upon departure.
7. Throughout the delivery the team will endeavour to keep the owner up to date regularly with progress updates and latest ETA.
8. Upon arriving at your chosen destination, the team will once again go through the boat, bow to stern, to provide a post-delivery survey highlighting any issues discovered on passage and outlining the vessels condition before cleaning through the boat and departing.
